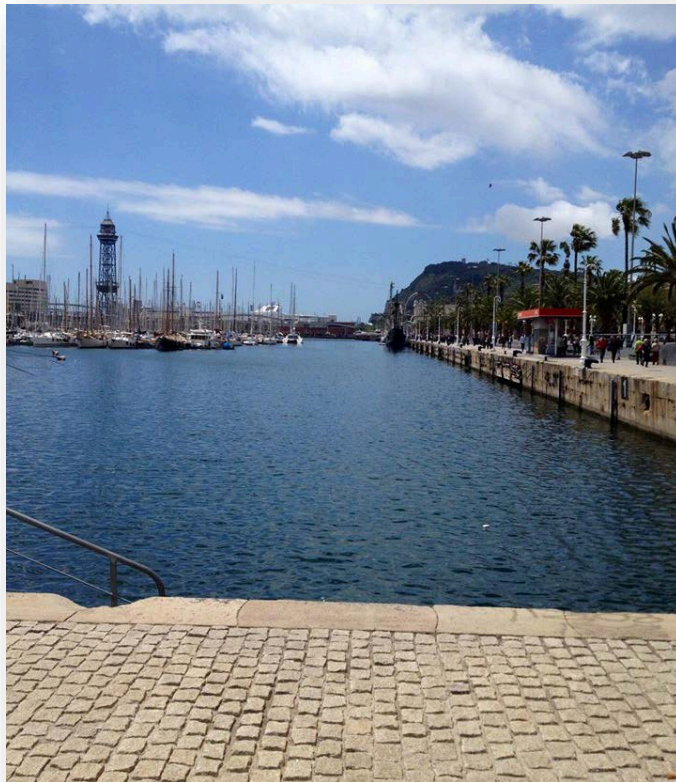

Getting to see Picasso's famous artwork up close was a once in a lifetime experience.

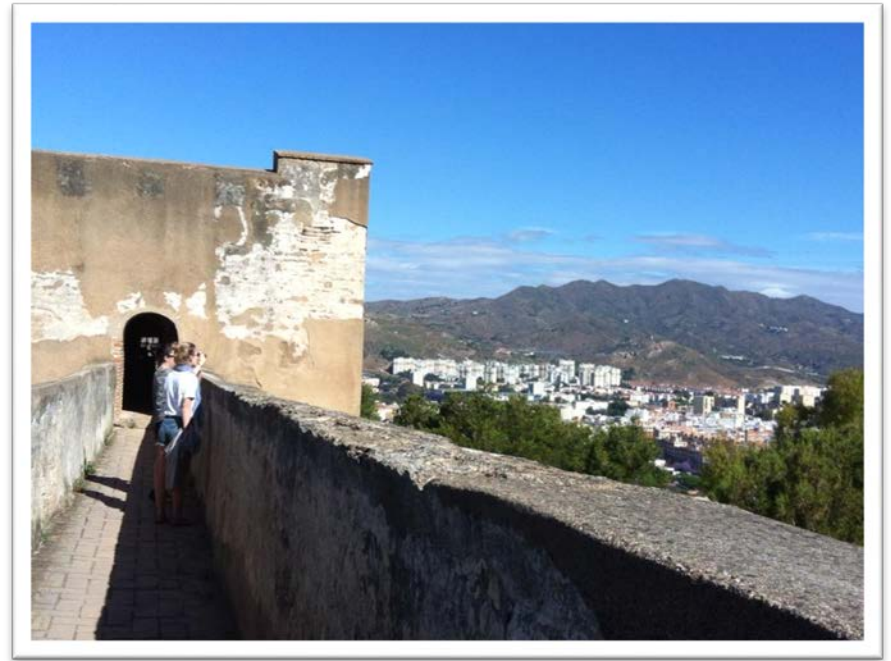
Barcelona – The Port
