- To make lifelong friends

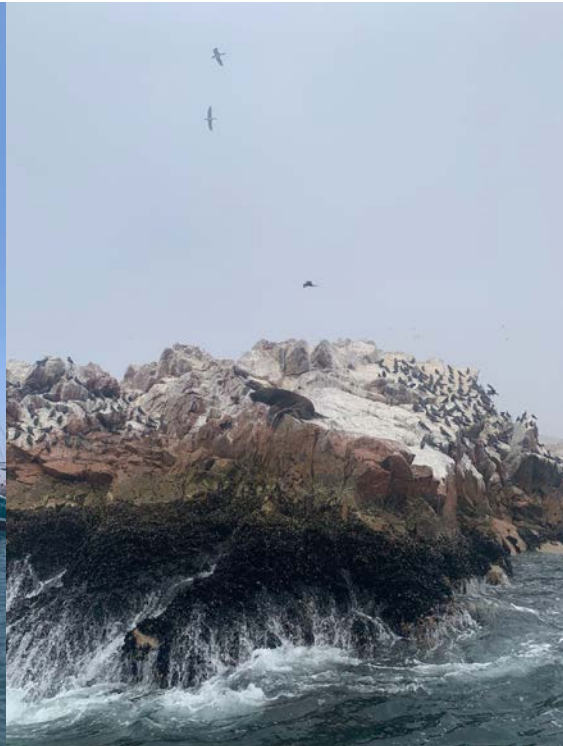

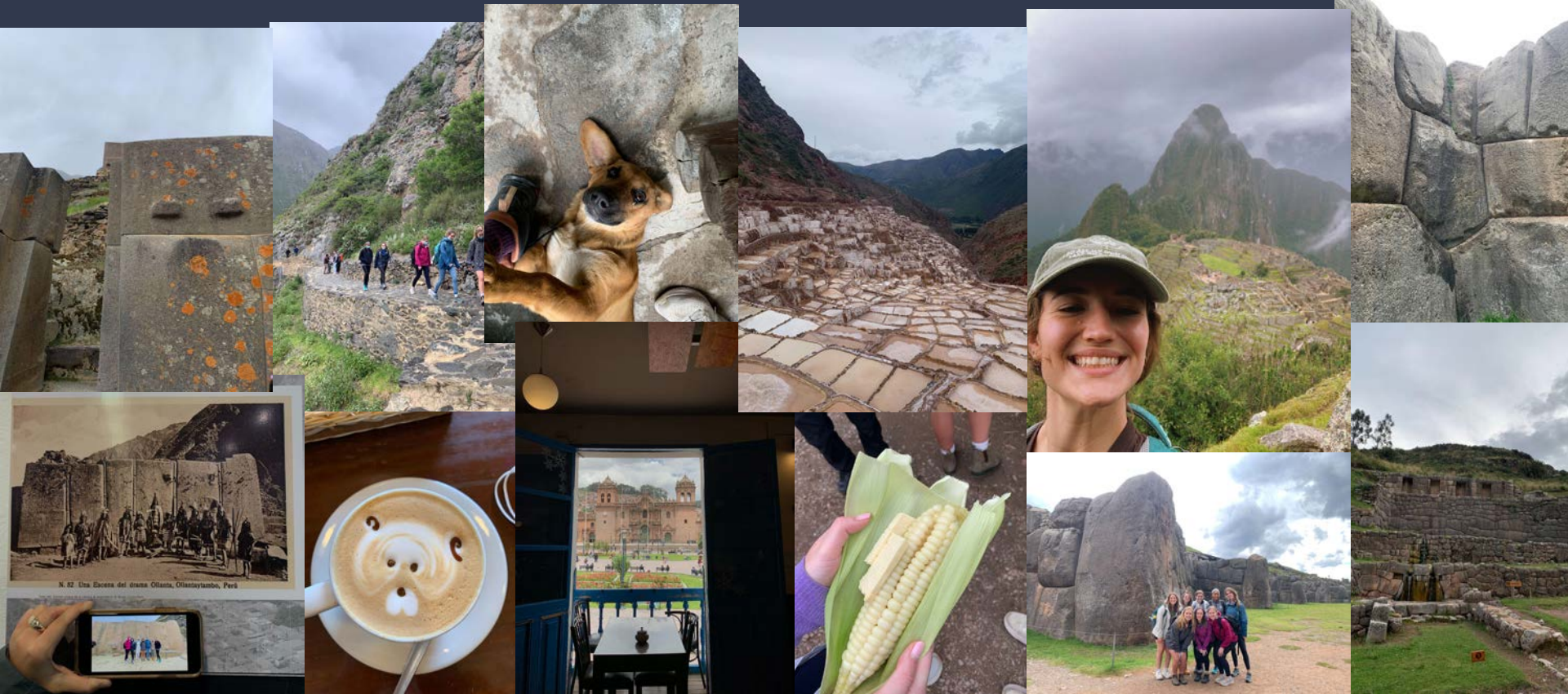

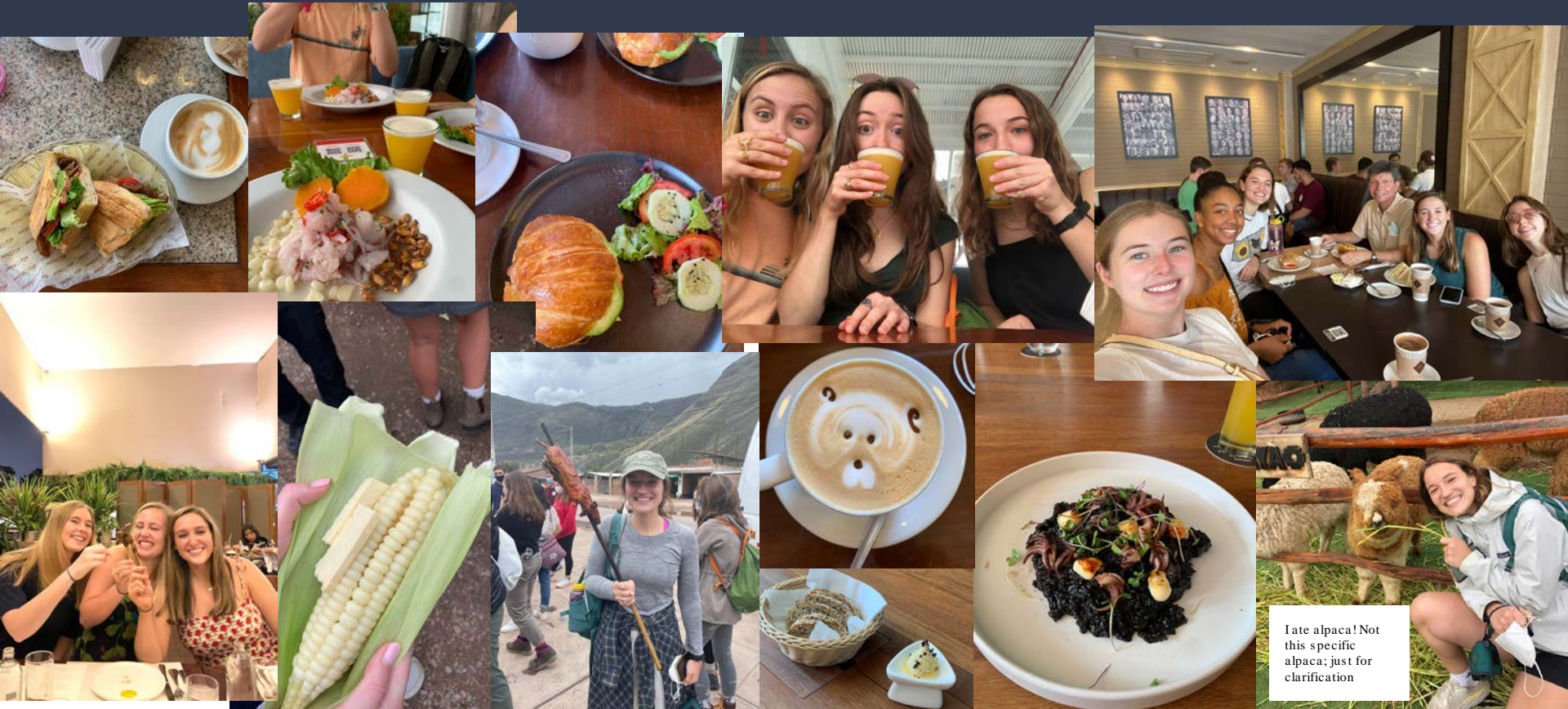
