My favorite adventure was to the Byzantine walls and castle at the top of the city.

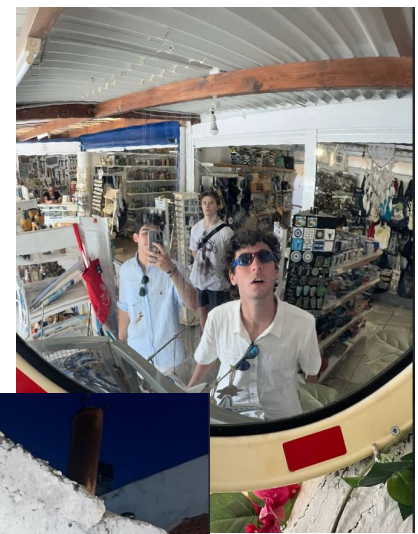
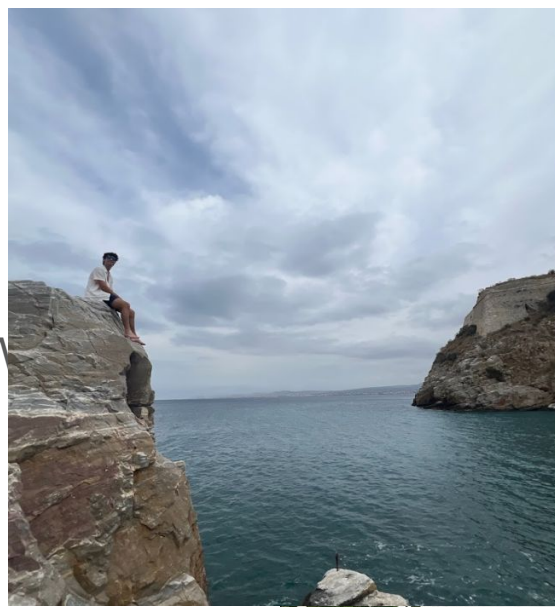

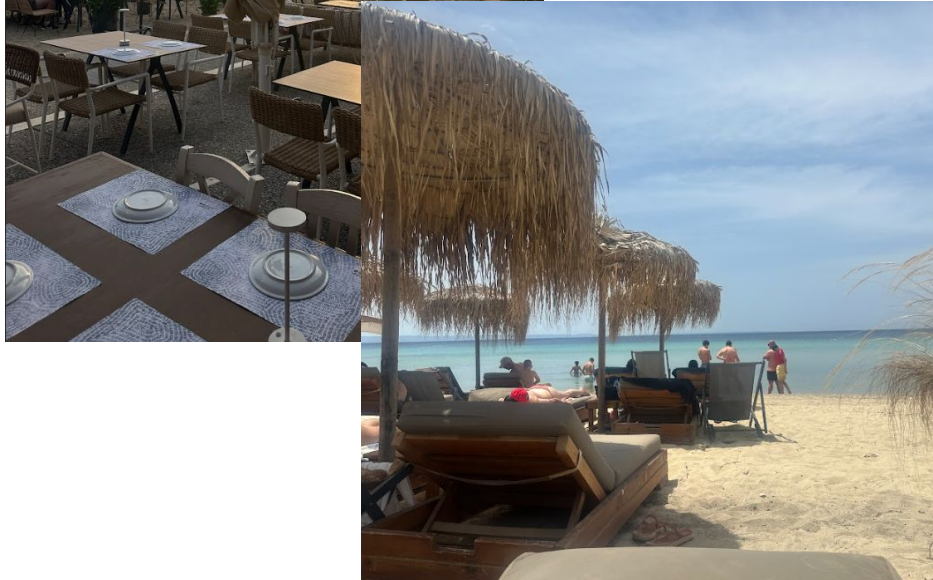


# Weekend in Crete
